Attending School During COVID-19





YOURCHILDCAN

Attend school

No one in the household is symptomatic, awaiting COVID test results, nor is a close contact to a case *Costent updated March 2021

YOUR CHILD
MUST STAY HOME

If the student or household member is sick Sick and NOT COVID tested

> Sick and COVID tested

The entirehousehold must isolate for 10 days from symptom onset. They can return after 24 hours of being symptom-free

If results are negative, the student can return after 24 hours of being symptom-free

YOUR CHILD
MUST STAY HOME

If the student or household member is a close contact to a COVID case The entire household must self-isolate for 14 days. The close contact (only) will be asked to take a COVID test 10 days after the last exposure to a case

COVID TEST



The entire household must continue to self-isolate — public health will provide direction

NEGATIVE COVID TEST



Close contact must continue to self-isolate for the entire 14 days — household members can return to school if the close contact test was done a minimum of seven days after exposure

YOUR CHILD MUSTSTAY HOME

If the student or household member has travelled outside Manitoba Traveller must self-isolate away from other household members, for 14 days. If this is not possible, the entire household must self-isolate with the traveller



*A note on COVID-19 Variants of Concern (VOC)

If a close contact is linked to a VOC case and the contact chooses not to be tested, they must self-isolate for 14 days, followed by an additional 10 days, for a total of 24 days. The rest of the household must also self-isolate for the entire 24 days.
